

## ***Call for Live Demo Presentation***

The **Silicon Saxony Day 2018** invites proposals for **Live Demonstrations** to be held during the 13<sup>th</sup> Silicon Saxony Day on **29 May 2018** in **Dresden**, Germany.

We offer you the opportunity to present your **innovative technology, product or application live on stage** in a 10-15 minutes **Demo Jam Session** to other companies and research institutions.

This Demo Jam Session offers the possibility for an interactive and tangible form of presentation which is quite different from oral sessions.

### ***Submission of proposals***

The demonstrations can be related to the topic human-machine-interaction or the topics of our expert sessions (Digital Entrepreneurship, From Sensors to Smart Systems, Interoperability for Industrial Internet of Things, Wearables).

Authors are invited to submit a title and abstract (100 words) describing the technology being demonstrated and the equipment that will be used for the demonstration (media, internet, live-image transfer). The abstract must clearly explain how the proposed demo is innovative and of interest for Silicon Saxony Day attendees. Please include a picture and/or screenshot of your demo.

Demonstrators are responsible for the transportation (including insurance) of their own equipment to the event venue. Indicate any special requirements such as for example extra space for demonstrating robotic movement or other requirements, which the organizers should be aware of.

**Proposals** shall be submitted by email to **Carola Schulze** ([carola.schulze@silicon-saxony.de](mailto:carola.schulze@silicon-saxony.de)). Accepted proposals will need to provide additional material (1 slide teaser, half page description) for inclusion to our website.
